Notes

- Seven of the top 20 counties with the highest percentage of Aztecán speakers are located in Texas. Seven more are in California.
- Aztecán is the 54th most common language spoken in Texas and the 72nd (tied) most common language spoken in Colorado.
- Aztecán is the third most common language spoken at home in Maverick County, Texas and the sixth most common language in Val Verde County, Texas.
- In the United States, 1 of every 46,769 people age five and older speaks Aztecán at home. In California, this figure is 1 in 13,718 people, while in Texas, 1 in 15,331 residents is an Aztecán speaker.
- Within the counties, Maverick County, Texas has the greatest rate of Aztecán speakers (1 in every 1,413 residents), followed by Yakima County, Wash. (1 in every 1,623 residents) and Weld County, Colo. (1 in every 2,082 residents).
