## Notes

- All of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Cajun speakers are located in Louisiana.
- The county with the highest percentage of speakers of Cajun that was not in Louisiana was Orange County, Texas (No. 22, 0.241%).
- Cajun is the fifth most common language spoken in Louisiana and the 20th most common language spoken in Mississippi.
- Cajun is the third most common language spoken at home in Acadia Parish, La., Evangeline Parish, La., Jefferson Davis Parish, La., Lafourche Parish, La., St. Landry Parish, La., and Vermilion Parish,
- In the United States, 1 of every 15,219 people age five and older speaks Cajun at home. In Louisiana, this figure is 1 in 289 people, while in Mississippi, 1 in 7,439 residents is a Cajun speaker.
- Within the counties, Evangeline Parish, La. has the greatest rate of Cajun speakers (1 in every 39 residents), followed by Lafourche Parish, La. (1 in every 46 residents) and Vermilion Parish, La. (1 in every 47 residents).
