Notes

- Passaic County, N.J. has two-and-one-half times the percentage of Caucasian speakers of any other county in the United States.
- New Jersey and New York are each home to five of the 19 counties where Caucasian speakers were recorded.
- Caucasian is the 59th most common language spoken in Georgia and the 69th most common language spoken in New Jersey.
- In the United States, 1 of every 59,093 people age five and older speaks Caucasian at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 11,600 people, while in New Jersey, 1 in 11,724 residents is a Caucasian speaker.
- Within the counties, Passaic County, N.J. has the greatest rate of Caucasian speakers (1 in every 1,206 residents), followed by DeKalb County, Ga. (1 in every 3,017 residents) and Queens County, N.Y. (1 in every 3,763 residents).
