Notes

- Speakers of Chadic tend to be bunched in New York and Maryland. Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of the Chadic speakers, these two states are home to five apiece.
- Chadic is the 64th most common language spoken in Maryland and the 79th most common language spoken in New York.
- In the United States, 1 of every 81,483 people age five and older speaks Chadic at home. In Maryland, this figure is 1 in 8,674 people, while in New York, 1 in 17,838 residents is a Chadic speaker.
- Within the counties, Prince George's County, Md. has the greatest rate of Chadic speakers (1 in every 1,956 residents), followed by Bronx County, N.Y. (1 in every 2,058 residents) and Richmond County, N.Y. (1 in every 3,066 residents).
