- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Chinese speakers, six are located in California, including three of the top four. Four others are found in New York, with two each in Massachusetts, New Jersey and Texas.
- San Francisco County, Calif. has more than double the percentage of Chinese speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Chinese is the third most common language spoken in New York and the fourth most common language spoken in California and Maryland.
- Chinese is the second most common language spoken at home in Norfolk County, Mass., and third most common language in 44 counties spread across 27 states.
- In the United States, 1 of every 175 people age five and older speaks Chinese at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 52 people, while in New York, 1 in 58 residents is a Chinese speaker.
- Within the counties, San Francisco County, Calif. has the greatest rate of Chinese speakers (1 in every 8.3 residents), followed by Queens County, N.Y. (1 in every 20 residents) and Alameda County, Calif. (1 in every 23 residents).
