## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Choctaw speakers, all are located in Mississippi and Oklahoma. Mississippi lays claim to six counties, including four of the top six. The remaining 14 are found in Oklahoma.
- Neshoba County, Miss. has more than three time the percentage and more than three times the number of Choctaw speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Choctaw is the fifth most common language spoken in Mississippi and the 10th most common language spoken in Oklahoma.
- Choctaw is the second most common language spoken at home in Kemper County, Miss., Leake County, Miss., Neshoba County, Miss. and Newton County, Miss.
- In the United States, 1 of every 23,035 people age five and older speaks Choctaw at home. In Mississippi, this figure is 1 in 487 people, while in Oklahoma, 1 in 952 residents is a Choctaw speaker.
- Within the counties, Neshoba County, Miss. has the greatest rate of Choctaw speakers ( 1 in every 9.8 residents), followed by Leake County, Miss. (1 in every 33 residents) and McCurtain County, Okla. (1 in every 39 residents).
