## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Efik speakers, five were located in Maryland (three of these in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area) and three in Georgia.
- Harris County, Texas is home to more than double the number of Efik speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Efik is the 48th most common language spoken in Rhode Island and the 51st most common language spoken in Louisiana.
- In the United States, 1 of every 49,739 people age five and older speaks Efik at home. In Maryland, this figure is 1 in 8,310 people, while in Rhode Island, 1 in 8,563 residents is a Efik speaker.
- Within the counties, DeKalb County, Ga. has the greatest rate of Efik speakers (1 in every 2,249 residents), followed by St. Louis City, Mo. (1 in every 2,316 residents) and Prince George's County, Md. (1 in every 3,303 residents).
