Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Estonian, seven are located in New Jersey, including four of the top six. Connecticut and Maryland feature three counties each.
- Estonian is the 48th most common language spoken in Delaware, the 49th (tied) most common language spoken in Vermont and the 59th most common language spoken in New Jersey.
- In the United States, 1 of every 35,770 people age five and older speaks Estonian at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 6,983 people, while in Delaware, 1 in 8,611 residents is an Estonian speaker.
- Within the counties, Ocean County, N.J. has the greatest rate of Estonian speakers (1 in every 1,569 residents), followed by Windham County, Conn. (1 in every 1,859 residents) and Cumberland County, N.J. (1 in every 2,110 residents).
