Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Finnish speakers, eight are located in Michigan, including the top three and six of the top seven. Minnesota features seven counties.
- Finnish is the 14th most common language spoken in Minnesota and the 16th most common language spoken in Montana.
- Finnish is the second most common language spoken at home in nine counties in two states: Michigan (seven counties) and Minnesota (two counties).
- In the United States, 1 of every 6,597 people age five and older speaks Finnish at home. In Minnesota, this figure is 1 in 870 people, while in Michigan, 1 in 1,620 residents is a Finnish speaker.
- Within the counties, Baraga County, Mich. has the greatest rate of Finnish speakers (1 in every 20 residents), followed by Ontonagon County, Mich. (1 in every 21 residents) and Houghton County, Mich. (1 in every 33 residents).
