- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of French speakers, Louisiana is home to 12, including seven of the top eight. Maine follows with four counties.
- · French is the second most common language spoken in Louisiana, Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont and the third most common language in nine states.
- · French is the second most common language spoken at home in 76 counties, led by Louisiana (28 counties), Maine (15), Vermont (13) and New Hampshire (10).
- In the United States, 1 of every 163 people age five and older speaks French at home. In Maine, this figure is 1 in 19 people, while in Louisiana, 1 in 23 residents is a French speaker.
- Within the counties, St. Martin Parish, La. has the greatest rate of French speakers (1 in every 3.8 residents), followed by Evangeline Parish, La. (1 in every 4.3 residents) and Vermilion Parish, La. (1 in every 4.4 residents).
