Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Gujarathi speakers, 10 are located in New Jersey, including five of the top six, and seven of the top 10. Three other counties are located in Georgia.
- Gujarathi is the eighth most common language spoken in Georgia and the ninth most common language spoken in New Jersey.
- Gujarathi is the third most common language spoken at home in Hendry County, Fla., Tift County, Ga., Middlesex County, N.J., and Rockwall County, Texas.
- In the United States, 1 of every 1,112 people age five and older speaks Gujarathi at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 166 people, while in Illinois, 1 in 402 residents is a Gujarathi speaker.
- Within the counties, Middlesex County, N.J. has the greatest rate of Gujarathi speakers (1 in every 46 residents), followed by Hudson County, N.J. (1 in every 72 residents) and DuPage County, Ill. (1 in every 119 residents).
