Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Hebrew speakers, seven are located in New York, including six of the top seven.
- Hebrew is the 14th most common language spoken in New York and the 17th most common language spoken in Florida.
- Hebrew is the fourth most common language spoken at home in Archer County, Texas and the fifth most common language in eight counties spread across eight states.
- In the United States, 1 of every 1,343 people age five and older speaks Hebrew at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 262 people, while in New Jersey, 1 in 524 residents is a Hebrew speaker.
- Within the counties, Rockland County, N.Y. has the greatest rate of Hebrew speakers (1 in every 80 residents), followed by Kings County, N.Y. (1 in every 88 residents) and New York County, N.Y. (1 in every 145 residents).
