- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Hungarian, seven are located in Ohio, including four of the top six. Four others are found in New Jersey.
- Hungarian is the 12th most common language spoken in Ohio and the 17th (tied) most common language spoken in West Virginia.
- Hungarian is the fifth most common language spoken at home in Stokes County, N.C., Lorain County, Ohio, Ottawa County, Ohio, Paulding County, Ohio, and Wise County, Va.
- In the United States, 1 of every 2,224 people age five and older speaks Hungarian at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 700 people, while in Connecticut 1 in 802 residents is a Hungarian speaker.
- Within the counties, Middlesex County, N.J. has the greatest rate of Hungarian speakers (1 in every 221 residents), followed by Geauga County, Ohio (1 in every 232 residents) and Cuyahoga County, Ohio (1 in every 270 residents).
