Notes

- Hawaii is home to the four counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Ilocano.
- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Ilocano, California is home to 11, while four are located in Hawaii, and four more in Alaska.
- Honolulu County, Hawaii has four times the number of Ilocano speakers than any other county in the United States.
- Ilocano is the fourth most common language spoken in Hawaii and the 25th most common language spoken in Alaska.
- Ilocano is the second most common language spoken at home in Kauai County, Hawaii and the third most common language in Maui County, Hawaii
- In the United States, 1 of every 3,470 people age five and older speaks Ilocano at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 25 people, while in Alaska, 1 in 1,286 residents is a Ilocano speaker.
- Within the counties, Maui County, Hawaii has the greatest rate of Ilocano speakers (1 in every 16 residents), followed by Kauai County, Hawaii (1 in every 17 residents) and Honolulu County, Hawaii (1 in every 27 residents).
