Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of India, n.e.c., nine are located in New Jersey.
- India, n.e.c. is the 21st most common language spoken in Delaware and the 24th most common language spoken in New Jersey and (tied) West Virginia.
- India, n.e.c. is the fifth most common language spoken at home in Webb County, Texas, and the sixth most common language in Russell County, Ala.
- In the United States, 1 of every 3,270 people age five and older speaks India, n.e.c. at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 783 people, while in Delaware, 1 in 1,394 residents is an India, n.e.c. speaker.
- Within the counties, Hudson County, N.J. has the greatest rate of India, n.e.c. speakers (1 in every 309 residents), followed by Queens County, N.Y. (1 in every 379 residents) and Middlesex County, N.J. (1 in every 380 residents).
