## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Indonesian, five are located in California.
- Los Angeles County, California has more than double the number of Indonesian speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Indonesian is the 28 th most common language spoken in Iowa and the 31st (tied) most common language spoken in Kentucky.
- Indonesian is the fifth most common language spoken at home in Luna County, N.M., and the sixth most common language in Independence County, Ark. and Henderson County, Ky.
- In the United States, 1 of every 5,450 people age five and older speaks Indonesian at home. In California, this figure is 1 in 1,502 people, while in Hawaii, 1 in 3,023 residents is a Indonesian speaker.
- Within the counties, Story County, Iowa has the greatest rate of Indonesian speakers (1 in every 343 residents), followed by San Bernadino County, Calif. (1 in every 419 residents) and Benton County, Ore. (1 in every 433 residents).
