Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Italian speakers, all but one are located in the northeastern United States. Eight of the top 20 are found in New York, including the top four, while New Jersey and Connecticut lay claim to four each. The only non-northeastern county on the list is Macomb County, Mich.
- Italian is the third most common language spoken in Connecticut, New Jersey and Pennsylvania.
- Italian is the second most common language spoken at home in Macomb County, Mich., Lawrence County, Pa., Brooke County, W.Va., and Hancock County, W.Va.
- In the United States, 1 of every 260 people age five and older speaks Italian at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 60 people, while in Connecticut, 1 in 63 residents is a Italian speaker.
- Within the counties, Richmond County, N.Y. has the greatest rate of Italian speakers (1 in every 23 residents), followed by Westchester County, N.Y. (1 in every 29 residents) and Putnam County, N.Y. (1 in every 31 residents).
