- In the United States, 1 of every 549 people age five and older speaks Japanese at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 20 people, while in California, 1 in 203 residents is a Japanese speaker.
- Within the counties, Honolulu County, Hawaii has the greatest rate of Japanese speakers (1 in every 18 residents), followed by Hawaii County, Hawaii (1 in every 25 residents) and Maui County, Hawaii (1 in every 36 residents).
