## Notes

- The four counties with the greatest percentage of Japanese speakers were all located in Hawaii.
- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Japanese speakers, California is home to six, while Hawaii and Washington state each lay claim to four.
- Japanese is the third most common language spoken in Hawaii and the fifth most common language spoken in Idaho.
- Japanese is the second most common language spoken at home in Hawaii County, Hawaii, and the third most common language in 10 counties spread across nine states.
- In the United States, 1 of every 549 people age five and older speaks Japanese at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 20 people, while in California, 1 in 203 residents is a Japanese speaker.
- Within the counties, Honolulu County, Hawaii has the greatest rate of Japanese speakers (1 in every 18 residents), followed by Hawaii County, Hawaii ( 1 in every 25 residents) and Maui County, Hawaii (1 in every 36 residents).
