Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Kannada, four are located in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area, and three are found in Texas.
- Santa Clara County, Calif. has more than double the number of Kannada speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Kannada is the 29th (tied) most common language spoken in West Virginia, the 45th most common language spoken in New Jersey, and the 46th most common language in Louisiana and (tied) Delaware.
- In the United States, 1 of every 10,757 people age five and older speaks Kannada at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 3,430 people, while in Maryland, 1 in 4,621 residents is a Kannada speaker.
- Within the counties, Santa Clara County, Calif. has the greatest rate of Kannada speakers (1 in every 630 residents), followed by Middlesex County, N.J. (1 in every 671 residents) and Somerset County, N.J. (1 in every 873 residents).
