## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Krio speakers, the top five are all located in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area. Four more are located in Georgia.
- Alexandria city, Va. is home to more than double the percentage of Krio speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Krio is the 45 th most common language spoken in the District of Columbia, the 48th (tied) most common language spoken in Maryland, and the 54th (tied) most common language spoken in Virginia.
- In the United States, 1 of every 55,120 people age five and older speaks Krio at home. In the District of Coumbia, this figure is 1 in 3,852 people, while in Maryland, 1 in 4,621 residents is a Krio speaker.
- Within the counties, Alexandria city, Va. has the greatest rate of Krio speakers (1 in every 614 residents), followed by Prince Georges County, Md. ( 1 in every 1,736 residents) and Montgomery County, Md. ( 1 in every 1,959 residents).
