- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Kru/Ibo/Yoruba, seven are located in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area. An additional four are located in New Jersey, with four more in Georgia.
- Kru/Ibo/Yoruba is the seventh most common language spoken in Maryland and the eighth most common language spoken in the District of Columbia.
- Kru/Ibo/Yoruba is the third most common language spoken at home in Prince Georges County, Md., and the fourth most common language in Bronx County, N.Y.
- In the United States, 1 of every 1,464 people age five and older speaks Kru/Ibo/Yoruba at home. In Maryland, this figure is 1 in 249 people, while in the District of Columbia, 1 in 282 residents is a Kru/Ibo/Yoruba speaker.
- Within the counties, Prince Georges County, Md. has the greatest rate of Kru/Ibo/Yoruba speakers (1 in every 79 residents), followed by Alexandria city, Va. (1 in every 86 residents) and Bronx County, N.Y. (1 in every 94 residents).
