Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Mande, four are located in Maryland, while New York and New Jersey are home to three apiece.
- Mande is the 37th (tie) most common language spoken in Rhode Island and the 43th most common language spoken in Maryland and Minnesota.
- In the United States, 1 of every 21,262 people age five and older speaks Mande at home. In Maryland, this figure is 1 in 3,676 people, while in Rhode Island, 1 in 4,476 residents is a Mande speaker.
- Within the counties, Bronx County, N.Y. has the greatest rate of Mande speakers (1 in every 1,065 residents), followed by Prince Georges County, Md. (1 in every 1,416 residents) and Richmond County, N.Y. (1 in every 1,656 residents).
