Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Marathi, New Jersey is home to five, followed by Virginia with four.
- Marathi is the 33rd (tie) most common language spoken in West Virginia and the 40th most common language spoken in Kentucky (tie) and New Jersey.
- In the United States, 1 of every 7,494 people age five and older speaks Marathi at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 1,761 people, while in California, 1 in 4,117 residents is a Marathi speaker.
- Within the counties, Middlesex County, N.J. has the greatest rate of Marathi speakers (1 in every 389 residents), followed by Fairfax city, Va. (1 in every 437 residents) and Santa Clara County, Calif. (1 in every 437 residents).
