Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Ojibwa, Minnesota is home to 11, while six more are in Wisconsin.
- Ojibwa is the 16th most common language spoken in North Dakota and the 17th most common language spoken in Minnesota.
- Ojibwa is the second most common language spoken at home in Beltrami County, Minn., Cass County, Minn., Mahnomen County, Minn., Rolette County, N.D., and Sawyer County, Wis.
- In the United States, 1 of every 31,403 people age five and older speaks Ojibwa at home. In Minnesota, this figure is 1 in 1,074 people, while in North Dakota, 1 in 2,153 residents is a Ojibwa speaker.
- Within the counties, Beltrami County, Minn. has the greatest rate of Ojibwa speakers (1 in every 42 residents), followed by Sawyer County, Wis. (1 in every 49 residents) and Cass County, Minn. (1 in every 62 residents).
