Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Oto-Manguen speakers, 12 are located in California.
- Madera County, Calif. has more than twice the percentage of Oto-Manguen speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Los Angeles County, Calif. has more than double the number of Oto-Manguen speakers of any other county in the nation and is home to 23.4 percent of the Oto-Manguen speakers nationwide.
- Oto-Manguen is the 62nd most common language spoken in South Carolina and the 68th most common language spoken in California.
- Oto-Manguen is the fourth most common language spoken at home in Clinton County, Ind. and the sixth most common language in Madera County, Calif.
- In the United States, 1 of every 45,511 people age five and older speaks Oto-Manguen at home. In California, this figure is 1 in 8,378 people, while in Oregon, 1 in 20,637 residents is a Oto-Manguen speaker.
- Within the counties, Madera County, Calif. has the greatest rate of Oto-Manguen speakers (1 in every 348 residents), followed by Clinton County, Ind. (1 in every 785 residents).
