- Madera County, Calif. has more than twice the percentage of Oto-Manguen speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Los Angeles County, Calif. has more than double the number of Oto-Manguen speakers of any other county in the nation and is home to 23.4 percent of the Oto-Manguen speakers nationwide.
