Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Pashto speakers, seven are located in California, five in New York and four in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area.
- Queens County, N.Y. is home to 15.4 percent of the Pashto speakers in the United States.
- Pashto is the 58th most common language spoken in Virginia and the 70th most common language spoken in New York and Utah.
- In the United States, 1 of every 34,030 people age five and older speaks Pashto at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 10,056 people, while in Virginia, 1 in 10,261 residents is a Pashto speaker.
- Within the counties, Yolo County, Calif. has the greatest rate of Pashto speakers (1 in every 1,308 residents), followed by Contra Costa County, Calif. (1 in every 1,606 residents) and Fairfax County, Va. (1 in every 1,751 residents).
