- Lancaster County, Pa. has more than double the number of Pennsylvania Dutch speakers than any other county in the United States.
- Pennsylvania Dutch is the sixth most common language spoken in Pennsylvania and Indiana.
- Pennsylvania Dutch is the second most common language spoken ain 10 counties across six states: Kentucky, Missoui, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania and West Virginia.
- In the United States, 1 of every 3,134 people age five and older speaks Pennsylvania Dutch at home. In Pennsylvania, this figure is 1 in 292 people, while in Ohio, 1 in 648 residents is a Pennsylvania Dutch speaker.
- Within the counties, Holmes County, Ohio has the greatest rate of Pennsylvania Dutch speakers (1 in every 5 residents), followed by LaGrange County, Ind. (1 in every 10 residents) and Davis County, Iowa (1 in every 20 residents).
