Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of speakers of Romanian, four were located in Washington, with two each in Idaho and New York.
- Romanian is the 11th most common language spoken in Oregon and the 18th most common language spoken in Idaho and Michigan.
- Romanian is the third most common language spoken at home in Canyon County, Idaho and the fourth most common language in Stark County, Ind.
- In the United States, 1 of every 2,285 people age five and older speaks Romanian at home. In Oregon, this figure is 1 in 676 people, while in Michigan, 1 in 987 residents is a Romanian speaker.
- Within the counties, Stark County, Ind. has the greatest rate of Romanian speakers (1 in every 162 residents), followed by Multnomah County, Ore. (1 in every 188 residents) and Queens County, N.Y. (1 in every 190 residents).
