## Notes

- Of the 19 counties where Romany speakers were recorded, three were located in California, two in Michigan and two in Texas.
- Romany is the 53rd (tied) most common language spoken in West Virginia and the 64th (tied) most common language spoken in Oregon.
- Romany is the eighth most common language spoken at home in Waldo County, Maine.
- In the United States, 1 of every 102,091 people age five and older speaks Romany at home. In Oregon, this figure is 1 in 11,424 people, while in Utah, 1 in 33,721 residents is a Romany speaker.
- Within the counties, Waldo County, Me. has the greatest rate of Romany speakers (1 in every 1,708 residents), followed by Multnomah County, Ore. (1 in every 2,207 residents) and Smith County, Texas (1 in every 6,482 residents).
