## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Russian speakers, four are located in New York, with two each in California, Alaska, Oregon and Massachusetts.
- Kings County, N.Y. (Brooklyn) is home to 19.3 percent of the nation's Russian speaking population, more than triple any other county in the U.S.
- Russian is the fifth most common language spoken in New York and Oregon and the seventh most common language spoken in Colorado.
- Russian is the second most common language spoken at home in Kenai Peninsula Borough, Alaska and the third most common language in 16 counties located in 11 states.
- In the United States, 1 of every 372 people age five and older speaks Russian at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 81 people, while in Washington State, 1 in 176 residents is a Russian speaker.
- Within the counties, Kings County, N.Y. has the greatest rate of Russian speakers ( 1 in every 17 residents), followed by the southeast Fairbanks Census Area, Alaska (1 in every 25 residents) and San Francisco County, Calif. (1 in every 46 residents).
