- Sebuano is the 49th (tied) most common language spoken in Alaska, the 52nd (tied) most common language spoken in Hawaii and the 58th (tied) most common language in Montana.
- In the United States, 1 of every 36,165 people age five and older speaks Sebuano at home. In Alaska, this figure is 1 in 6,811 people, while in Hawaii, 1 in 10,308 residents is a Sebuano speaker.
- Within the counties, Stevens County, Wash. has the greatest rate of Sebuano speakers (1 in every 2,502 residents), followed by Merced County, Calif. (1 in every 2,741 residents) and San Francisco County, Calif. (1 in every 3,312 residents).
