## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Serbocroatian, three were located in Vermont. Iowa and Idaho were home to two apiece.
- Serbocroatian is the fifth most common language spoken in Vermont and the sixth most common language spoken in Idaho and Iowa.
- Serbocroatian is the third most common language spoken at home in Twin Falls County, Idaho, Polk County, Iowa, Black Hawk County, Iowa, Warren County, Ky. and St. Louis city, Mo.
- In the United States, 1 of every 2,016 people age five and older speaks Serbocroatian at home. In Vermont, this figure is 1 in 379 people, while in Iowa, 1 in 477 residents is a Serbocroatian speaker.
- Within the counties, Black Hawk County, Iowa has the greatest rate of Serbocroatian speakers (1 in every 70 residents), followed by St. Louis city, Mo. (1 in every 71 residents) and Oneida County, N.Y. (1 in every 84 residents).
