- Of the 20 counties with the great percentage of Shoshoni speakers, eight are located in Nevada and five in Idaho.
- Elko County, Nev. is home to 16.0 percent of the Shoshoni speakers in the United States. Bannock County, Idaho, Bingham County, Idaho and Fremont County, Wyoming, account for 13.3 percent, 13.1 percent, and 12.9 percent, respectively. In all, these four counties represent 55.2 percent of the nation's Shoshoni speakers.
- Shoshoni is the seventh most common language spoken in Wyoming.
- Shoshoni is the third most common language spoken at home in Idaho's Power County, Bannock County and Bingham County and Nevada's Elko County and Lander County.
- In the United States, 1 of every 90,318 people age five and older speaks Shoshoni at home. In Wyoming, this figure is 1 in 984 people, while in Idaho, 1 in 1,221 residents is a Shoshoni speaker.
- Within the counties, Power County, Idaho has the greatest rate of Shoshoni speakers (1 in every 80 residents), followed by Elko County, Nev. (1 in every 89 residents) and Fremont County, Wyo. (1 in every 89 residents).
