Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Slovak speakers, 12 are located in Pennsylvania, including seven of the top nine. Six more counties can be found in Ohio.
- Slovak is the 19th most common language spoken in Pennsylvania and the 20th most common language spoken in Ohio.
- Slovak is the fourth most common language spoken at home in Fayette County, Pa. and Cambria County, Pa. and the fifth most common language in Montour County, Pa., Carbon County, Pa. and Mahoning County, Ohio.
- In the United States, 1 of every 6,353 people age five and older speaks Slovak at home. In Pennsylvania, this figure is 1 in 1,309 people, while in Ohio, 1 in 1,893 residents is a Slovak speaker.
- Within the counties, Montour County, Pa. has the greatest rate of Slovak speakers (1 in every 127 residents), followed by Carbon County, Pa. (1 in every 185 residents) and Mahoning County, Ohio (1 in every 227 residents).
