Notes

- Speakers of Slovene tend to be found along the Great Lakes. Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Slovene speakers, three-quarters are located in: Ohio, Pennsylvania (five counties each), Minnesota (two), Michigan, Wisconsin, Illinois and New York (one each). Three others are found in Colorado. Ohio accounts for four of the top six.
- Cuyahoga County, Ohio accounts for 17.1 percent of the Slovene speakers in the United States.
- The percentage of Slovene speakers in Lake County, Ohio is nearly double that of any other county in the United States.
- Slovene is the 27th (tied) most common language spoken in Ohio.
- Slovene is the sixth most common language spoken at home in Chaffee County, Colo. and Lake County, Ohio.
- In the United States, 1 of every 26,882 people age five and older speaks Slovene at home. In Ohio, this figure is 1 in 3,117 people.
- Within the counties, Lake County, Ohio, has the greatest rate of Slovene speakers (1 in every 219 residents).
