## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Tagalog, Alaska and California have seven counties each, while Hawaii places four counties.
- The percentage of Tagalog speakers in the Aleutians East Borough, Alaska, Aleutians West Census Area, Alaska, and Kodiak Island Borough, Alaska are significantly above the percentage of any other county in the United States.
- Los Angeles County, Calif. is home to 16 percent of the Tagalog speakers in the United States.
- Tagalog is the second most common language spoken in Hawaii and the third most common language spoken in California, Nevada and Washington.
- Tagalog is the second most common language spoken at home in eight counties - six in Alaska and two in Hawaii.
- In the United States, 1 of every 214 people age five and older speaks Tagalog at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 19 people, while in California, 1 in 50 residents is a Tagalog speaker.
