- Middlesex County, N.J. has nearly twice the percentage of Telugu speakers as any other county in the United States.
- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Telugu speakers, three are located in New Jersey, Illinois and the Washington, D.C. area.
- Telugu is the 19th most common language spoken in West Virginia and the 20th most common language spoken in Alabama.
- Telugu is the sixth most common language spoken at home in McLean County, Ill. and Boone County, Texas, and the seventh most common in Madison County, Ala. and Benton County, Ark.
- In the United States, 1 of every 3,045 people age five and older speaks Telugu at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 859 people, while in Michigan, 1 in 1,699 residents is a Telugu speaker.
- Within the counties, Middlesex County, N.J. has the greatest rate of Telugu speakers (1 in every 143 residents), followed by Santa Clara County, Calif. (1 in every 265 residents) and Fairfax city, Va. (1 in every 328 residents).
