## Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Thai speakers, four are located in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area.
- Thai is the 11th most common language spoken in Nevada and the 16th most common language spoken in Iowa.
- Thai is the third most common language spoken at home in Van Buren County, Tenn., and the fourth most common in Fremont County, Iowa and Humboldt County, Nev.
- In the United States, 1 of every 2,178 people age five and older speaks Thai at home. In Nevada, this figure is 1 in 513 people, while in Hawaii, 1 in 758 residents is a Thai speaker.
- Within the counties, Humboldt County, Nev. has the greatest rate of Thai speakers (1 in every 210 residents), followed by Okaloosa County, Fla. (1 in every 215 residents) and Hopewell city, Va. (1 in every 293 residents).
