- In the United States, 1 of every 10,902 people age five and older speaks Tongan at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 314 people, while in Utah, 1 in 391 residents is a Tongan speaker.
- Within the counties, Maui County, Hawaii has the greatest rate of Tongan speakers (1 in every 159 residents), followed by Salt Lake County, Utah (1 in every 179 residents), and San Mateo County, Calif. (1 in every 201 residents).
