Notes

- New York's Kings, Rockland and Orange Counties are home to 52.7 percent of the nation's Yiddish speaking population.
- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Yiddish speakers, New York is home to 10 of them, with Florida and New Jersey claiming an additional three apiece.
- Yiddish is the eighth most common language spoken in New York and the 15th most common language spoken in Florida.
- Yiddish is the third most common language spoken at home in Rockland County, N.Y. and Orange County, N.Y., and the fifth most common language in Kings County, N.Y.
- In the United States, 1 of every 1,466 people age five and older speaks Yiddish at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 156 people, while in Florida, 1 in 825 residents is a Yiddish speaker.
- Within the counties, Rockland County, N.Y. has the greatest rate of Yiddish speakers (1 in every 20 residents), followed by Orange County, N.Y. (1 in every 30 residents) and Kings County, N.Y. (1 in every 32 residents).
