Languages in Arizona

- Maricopa County's 110 languages tied for the third highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Arizona counties that were highly ranked included: Pima County (t-68), Mohave County (t-311) and Yavapai County (t-311).
- Arizona has the highest percentage of speakers of Apache, Hopi, and Pima in the United States. The Grand Canyon State also ranks second in the percentage of Navaho, Tewa and Zuni speakers.
- Apache County has the highest percentage of Navaho speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: Graham County (first, Apache), Navaho County (first, Hopi), Pinal County (first, Pima), and Santa Cruz County (ninth, Spanish).
