Languages in Indiana

- Marion County's 68 languages tied for the 77th highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Indiana counties that were highly ranked included: Lake County (t-181), St. Joseph County (t-194), Tippecanoe County (t-194), and Allen County (t-204).
- Indiana has the highest percentage of speakers of Dutch in the United States. The Hoosier State also ranks second in the percentage of Macedonian speakers and third in the percentage of Pennsylvania Dutch and Serbian speakers.
- Lake County has the highest percentage of Macedonian and Serbian speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: LaGrange County (first, Dutch), LaGrange County (second, Pennsylvania Dutch) and Elkhart County (eight, Dutch).
