Languages in Minnesota

- Hennepin County's 90 languages represented the 18th highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Minnesota counties that were highly ranked included: Ramsey County (t-52), Dakota County (t-138) and Anoka County (t-181).
- Minnesota has the highest percentage of speakers of Cushite, Finnish, Miao/Hmong, Ojibwa, Swedish and Tibetan in the United States. The North Star State also ranks second in the percentage of Lettish and Norwegian speakers and third in the percentage of Laotian, Mande and Swahili speakers.
- Ramsey County has the highest percentage of Miao/Hmong speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: Beltrami County (first, Ojibwa), Olmsted County (second, Cushite), Hennepin County (third, Cushite), Hennpin County (fourth, Mande), Olmsted County (fifth, Mon-Khmer/Cambodian).
