Languages in Vermont

- Chittenden County's 36 languages tied for the 252nd highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Vermont counties that were highly ranked included: Windham County (t-456) and Washington County (t-530).
- Vermont has the highest percentage of speakers of Serbocroatian in the United States. The Green Mountain State also ranks second in the percentage of Tibetan and Welsh speakers, third in the percentage of Mongolian speakers, and fourth in the percentage of French speakers.
- Chittenden County has the sixth highest percentage of Serbocroatian speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: Washington County (ninth, Serbocroatian), Franklin County (13th, Lettish), Caledonia County (17th, Serbocroatian), and Orleans County (18th French).
