Languages in Virginia

• Fairfax County's 92 languages represented the 16th
highest number recorded in any county in the
United States. Other Virginia counties that were
highly ranked included: Arlington County (t-85),
Virginia Beach city (t-151), Prince William County
(t-155), Henrico County (t-162), Norfolk city (t-
174), and Alexandria city (t-181).
• Virginia has the second highest percentage of
speakers of Pashto and Persian in the United States.
The Old Dominion also ranks third in the percent-
age of Afrikaans, Amharic, Bengali, Icelandic, Krio
and Uighur speakers and fourth in the percentage of
Arabic, Mongolian, Nepali and Urdu speakers.
• Fairfax County has the highest percentage of Persian
speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties
that rank highly in a given language include:
Alexandria city (first, Amharic), Fairfax County
(second, Urdu), and Arlington County (second,
Amharic).
