## STATES, BY LANGUAGES

Languages in the United States: 322

The chart below displays the total number of languages recorded as being spoken at home in the 50 states of the United States and the District of Columbia (subject to Census confidentiality protections). Each figure should be looked at as a minimum number, as it is likely that each and every state in the United States had at least one additional language that was not reported due to confidentiality protections, or was not found by the sample done by the Census.
For example, there was one state where 56-60 languages were recorded as being spoken at home, accouting for 2.0 percent of the nation's 50 states plus the District of Columbia. Theere were 2 counties where 61-65 languages were recorded as being spoken at home, accounting for 4.0 percent of the nation's states plus Washington, D.C.
